BOARD OF EDUCATION  
JOINT MEETING WITH SACRED HEART SCHOOL BOARD  
MONDAY, MAY 9, 2011

The Maquoketa Community School Board of Education held a joint meeting with Sacred Heart on Monday, May 9, 2011 at 5:30 p.m. at Central Office. Sacred Heart Directors Prull and Murphy and Principal Angela Ruley were present. Maquoketa Directors Hawks, Pape, Hudrlik, Tabor and Schwenker were present. Supt. Huckstadt, Board Secretary McKeon, and Curriculum Director H Snell were present. Also present was Susan Risinger.

Pres. Schwenker welcomed everyone and introductions were made.

MOTION #144-10/11: Motion/Tabor, 2<sup>nd</sup>/Hawks to approve the agenda as presented. All ayes, motion carried.

Superintendent Huckstadt, Curriculum Director Snell and Sacred Heart Principal Ruley reviewed the following common programs and amounts for fiscal year 2010/11: Title II - \$795.20 for staff development; Title I –Maquoketa School’s allocation for 2010/11 is \$327,812 (a decrease of \$11,365 from prior year) plus ARRA funds of \$112,635. Six Sacred Heart students receive assistance in reading; Non-public Textbook Allocation – carry over funds from FY10 is \$41.22 and the FY11 allocation is \$1,290.98, bringing the total available of \$1,332.20; and the Band Program for next year will continue with Ms. Wold serving 5<sup>th</sup> grade Sacred Heart students and Mr. Kahn serving 6<sup>th</sup> grade students. Ms. Wold will continue as a .8 FTE, .5 as band instructor and .3 as Talented and Gifted.

Also reviewed was the concurrent/senior year plus courses and apprenticeship type courses offered at the High School level made possible by an agreement with Clinton Community College; it is planned that Sacred Heart will offer an afternoon class of voluntary preschool in addition to the morning classes offered this year. Funding of the programs from the State level is still unknown; enrollment projection for Sacred Heart is up slightly; and Supt. Huckstadt provided an overview of Maquoketa Schools allowable growth and budget guarantee with regard to funding for FY12.

Pres. Schwenker adjourned the meeting at 5:55 p.m.
