BOARD OF EDUCATION  
JOINT MEETING WITH DELWOOD SCHOOL BOARD  
MONDAY, JUNE 13, 2011

The Maquoketa Community School Board of Education held a joint meeting with Delwood School Board on Monday, June 13, 2011 at 5:15 p.m. at Central Office. Delwood Directors Denger, Tubbs, Filloon, Gerlach and Holtz and Maquoketa Directors Hudrlik, Pape and Schwenker were present. Director Hawks and Supt. Huckstadt were absent. Maquoketa Director Tabor arrived at 5:42 p.m. Delwood Supt. Goodall, Board Secretary Goodenow, and Maquoketa Board Secretary McKeon were present. Curriculum Director H Snell, High School Principal Vervaecke, Middle School Principal C Snell, and Technology Coordinator Cogan were present. Press was represented by Kelly Gerlach of Maquoketa Sentinel Press.

Pres. Schwenker welcomed everyone and introductions were made.

MOTION #165-10/11: Motion/Filloon, 2<sup>nd</sup>/Hudrlik to approve the agenda as presented. All ayes, motion carried.

Helen Snell, Director of School Improvement, reported on the following: Tentative Reading, Math and Science Proficiencies FAY Students in grades 7<sup>th</sup> through 11<sup>th</sup>; and a preview of staff development plans for 2011-12.

High School Principal Vervaecke and Middle School Principal C Snell reported on highlights of the past school year 2010-11 and anticipated changes for the upcoming school year, 2011-12.

Delwood Supt. Sue Goodall reported on the Facility Improvement Committee approved projects from proceeds from the Delwood LOSST/SAVE funds totaling \$63,000. The revised whole grade sharing agreement between the two districts was presented. Changes were made to reflect the certified enrollment count date of the first weekday in October (from 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday in September) and language for Concurrent Enrollment Supplementary Weighting. The State allows additional funding for Concurrent/Senior Year Plus qualified classes taken. The additional funding Delwood students generate will be sent to Maquoketa. Each Board of Education will take separate action to approve the revised agreement during a future regular meeting.
